

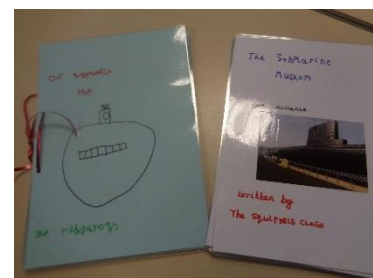
Week beginning 16<sup>th</sup> October
