

This week in English we have been continuing our work on contractions using the book "The Day the Crayons Quit" by Oliver Jeffers. We pretended that we were one of our own toys and we wrote a letter to ourselves explaining why we were quitting. We had to remember to include contractions.

In Maths we have been looking at the = sign and what it means. We learnt that each side of the equation had to be the same so that it balanced.

E.g $2 + 3 = 4 + 1$

We then used this to help us solve missing number sentences.

E.g $\square + 3 = 6 + \square$

This half term the Owls class will be working on Computing whilst the Badgers are learning music. They will swap over next half term. In Computing we have been looking at algorithms, how to write an algorithm, how to test it and how to debug it. First we wrote an algorithm to draw an alien. Our partners then followed our algorithm to draw the alien and we compared our pictures. We have also had to write an algorithm that would help a robot make a sandwich. We had to use specific words like "left hand" and "right hand". Mr Coppins pretended to be a robot and followed our algorithm.
