## Week beginning 15<sup>th</sup> January

This week in Maths the focus has been on subtraction. We have been working on solving problems using counters, recording iconically, and using number lines.

In English we looked at different pictures from around the world, before writing three noun phases about what we could see. We know that a noun phase is when you describe an object, place, person or a thing. Finally we used the concepts previously learnt about features of a postcard and noun phases to write our own postcard.

The focus in Science was on learning more about the different types of animals, before sorting the animals into the following categories; mammals, birds, reptiles, invertebrates, fish and amphibian, giving our reasons why.





During activity afternoon we worked across the year group, either participating in Science, Craft or Art activities. In Science we made rafts to help a Billy goat cross the river. When we tested the rafts on water we were looking to see whether they floated, were they waterproof, and could they hold a small weight. In Art we were drawing features of the face before moving on to drawing portraits. We had lots of fun designing our own monsters in Craft.
