

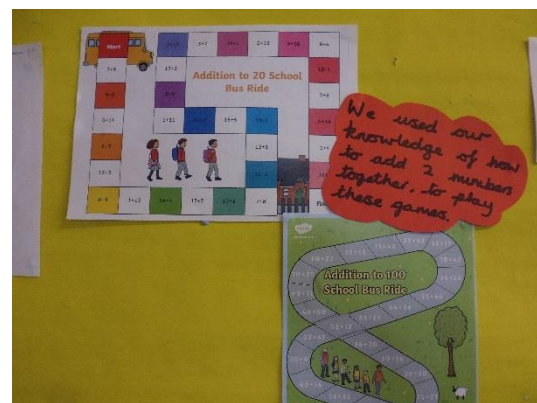
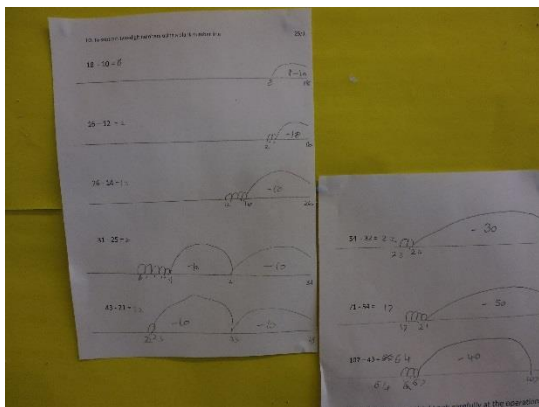
This week in English we have been looking at superlatives and comparatives. These are adjectives that end in *-est* or *-er*.

In groups we compared our height and the size of our hands. We found out who was the tallest and the shortest and who had the biggest and smallest hands. We then wrote sentences using these words.

E.g Harry was the tallest. He was taller than George.

Ava had the smallest hands. Her hands were smaller than Lexie's hands.

In Maths we have been using blank number lines to help us solve addition and subtraction number sentences. We also got to play a fun game that helped us practise what we had learnt.



In Music the Badgers have been composing their own music. We used our bodies to make different sounds (clapping, stamping) and then found our own way of recording on paper what we had done so that another group could copy our music.

During Forest Schools we continued our Science topic by looking for micro habitats. We recorded what animals we found and where we found them. If it was under a log we had to note whether the log was wet or dry and whether there were leaves or soil underneath and whether it was wet or dry.
