In Maths this week Year 2 have been working on place value. We began by making two digit numbers using dienes and partitioning them into tens and ones. We then wrote the number sentence that showed this.

Using the dienes we then explored the different ways we could partition the number.

E.g. 30 + 4 = 34

20 + 14 = 34

10 + 24 = 34

Once we noticed the pattern we were able to partition the number without using dienes.

This week in English we have been working on contractions using the book "Dogs Don't Do Ballet" as our focus. We have matched contractions with their route words and written sentences using the contractions.
