

Week Beginning 4th February

In Outdoor learning we participated in a variety of activities. Some of us made tidy habitats for a character from last week's Hampshire picture book, while others practised our knot tying skills when making decorations to hang in the trees.



The focus in Maths has been on learning about Doubles and Halves. We have used multi-link and proxy symbols to solve and record problems. We now know that when we half a number, each half needs to be equal, and when doubling we need to add the same amount again.

In English we have been focusing our learning around the third Hampshire Picture Book titled 'Bad Bunnies Magic Show'. We wrote speech bubbles for the characters in the story thinking of what they might be saying as well as how they might be saying it such as; trembled, roared, growled, squeaked etc. At the end of the week we looked at another book written by the same Author titled 'Toys in Space', thinking of the similarities and differences between the two stories.

On Friday we had lots of fun when we worked in small groups to design and make a parachute for a bear. This involved sharing our ideas, working together as a team and decision making. At the end of the morning we tested the parachutes and evaluated our designs.
