Week beginning 19th February

This week the focus in Maths has been on place value. We have learnt how to blow numbers apart, showing how many tens and ones in a given number.

Using practical equipment such as numicom and dienes we were able to clearly see the partitioning of numbers.

During Outdoor Learning we went on a seasons walk looking at signs of new life. We noticed blossom and buds appearing on trees and Daffodils and Snow Drops growing around the school.

In English we looked at the last of the Hampshire Picture Books titled 'Danny McGee Drinks the Sea'. We noticed the book had a rhyming text, which led us to try and think of a rhyming string for our names.

During P.E we practised the skills needed to play Hockey, passing, dribbling and pushing a ball through a gate.

In Science Cool Time there was a variety of activities linked to 'Animals'. We also explored sinking and floating, making predictions before testing to see if our predictions were correct. Our challenge was to find a way of making a ball of plastercine float. Some of us built bridges, using only two cups and a strip of sugar paper before testing how strong it was.
