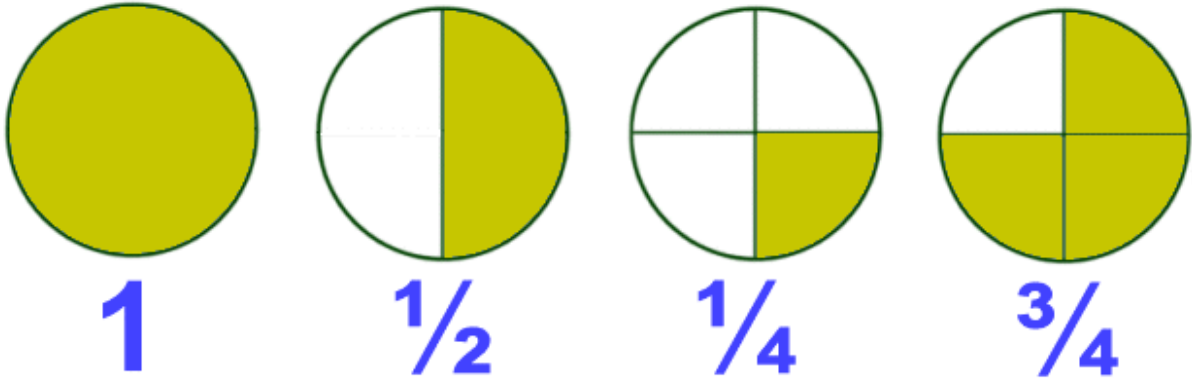


This week in Maths we have been telling the time. We have all become very good at o'clock and $\frac{1}{2}$ past and we have begun to understand where the minute hand would be pointing for $\frac{1}{4}$ past and $\frac{1}{4}$ to. You can help us at home by asking us to tell these times when you notice them. We have also begun to look at fractions. We have divided shapes into halves, thirds and quarters. We also wrote what fraction of a shape was shaded.



In English we once again looked at the artefacts from The Seacity Museum. We took notes as our teachers told us more about each item. We then used our notes to help us write a caption for one of the artefacts.

This half term as part of their Computing curriculum Badgers are using Lightbot to help them learn how to program.
