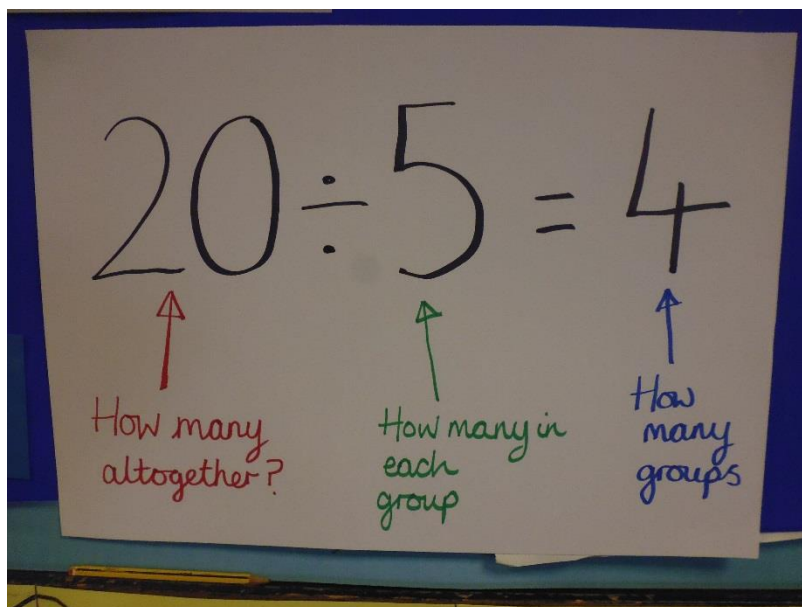


On Monday Year 2 were very excited to share with their friends the exciting things that they had done in the snow. We had made igloos, had snowball fights and been sledging.
