We have been very busy in Maths this week. We have continued looking at 3D shapes and exploring their properties. We had to find out how many vertices, faces and edges each shape had as well as remember their names. It was quite difficult to remember which edges we had already counted when we were looking at cubes and cuboids. We also thought about symmetry and whether our 2D shapes had lines of symmetry and if so how many. We have been practising reading scales. We had lots of different activities for measuring length using rulers and meter rulers. We had to remember that the unit of measurement for length is centimetres and metres. We also measured liquid in millilitres and litres, weight in grams and kilograms and temperature in degrees Celsius. It was a lot of fun.



In English we have continued our work on The Twits. We had to think of a new trick that Mr and Mrs Twit could play on each other. We then had to write about the trick including what was needed to carry out the trick, how it happened and what the result was. Some of our tricks were very mean! We have also been focusing on reading and in particular the skill of answering inference questions. These are tricky because we have to think about what the author meant or why they wrote something.
