

In RE this week we have been learning about how the festival of Holi helps people who follow the Hindu religion remember when good triumphed over evil in the story of Prahlad. During the festival of Holi coloured powders are thrown at the participants whilst they are drenched in water. We didn't think we ought to do that! We created works of art by throwing powder paint onto paper that had been watered and poster paint onto paper. We also brought in and talked about things that were special to us because they helped us remember special people or events.



This week in Science we have thought about what plants need to grow. In groups we had to think of an experiment that we could conduct that might affect the growth of a plant. We were given three seeds but were only allowed to change one thing that the seed was given. Our experiments will include:

How much water does it need?

How much light does a plant need?

How much warmth does a plant need?

Can you use different types of liquid?

We had to make a prediction as to what we thought might happen. We will be carrying out the experiment over the next couple of weeks to see if our predictions were accurate.

This week the whole school visited the Poppy art installation at Fort Nelson. We thought that they looked amazing.
