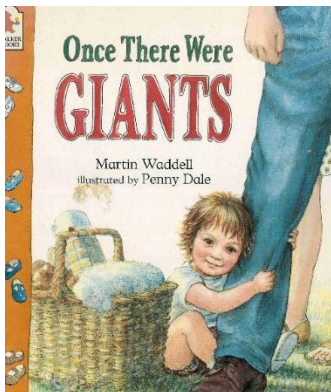


Week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> September
