

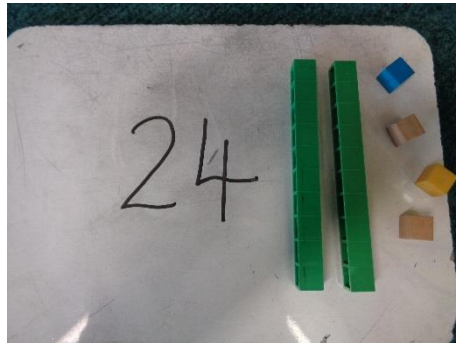
Week beginning 17th September

English

This week in English we have been focusing on questions. At the beginning of the week we listened to the story 'Dear Greenpeace' and identified what makes a question. We focused on the questioning words and the punctuation. At the end of the week we wrote letters to a variety of people, ie, famous people, relatives or friends and asked them a series of questions.

Maths

In maths we have been working on place value. We used dienes to draw the amount of 10's and 1's we would need to make for each number. We also investigated what we know about the number 14.

We have been practising writing the letters 'r' and 'h'.

PE

Our lesson on Wednesday was a continuation of last week. We practised putting 3 different ways of travelling into a sequence and then used this sequence on the apparatus.

On Thursday the focus was on ball skills in preparation for playing ball games. We were working on chest passes, shoulder passes and intercepting the ball.

Science

We had fun investigating various different animals and then sorted them into the categories for amphibians, reptiles, mammals, invertebrates and fish. We then individually wrote about the facts we knew about some animals plus we wrote questions about what we wanted to investigate further.

Reading Activities

During our Friday morning reading activities we split into groups and completed 4 different activities. We learnt how to use the See saw app that we will be using in our learning this year. We sat with a friend and looked at books together. We visited the library and investigated non-fiction books and our writing activity involved looking at 2 different pictures. With one picture we wrote descriptive sentences about what we could see whilst the other picture involved completing a connections grid with a partner.
