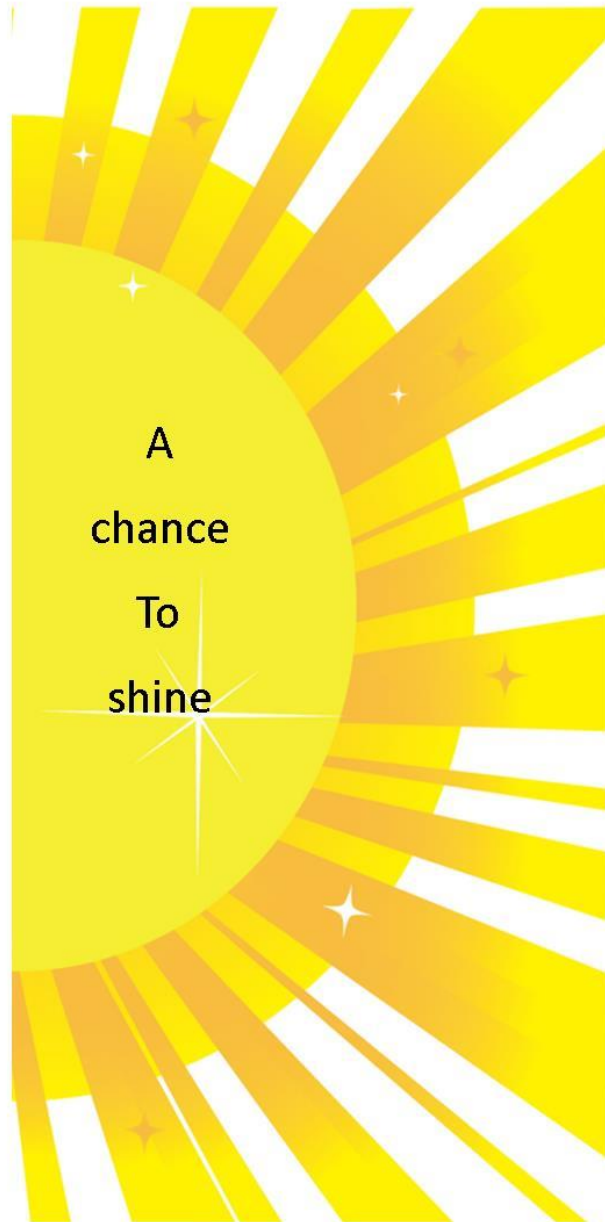


We will offer your child ...
