# Week beginning 1st October

# English

This week we have focused on Fairy Tales, in particular the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We began the week having the story read to us, we were then able to choose a variety of different activities based on the story. Some chose to make puppets and retell the story, others sequenced the story, some made story maps or drew the characters. We also made a list of all the other Fairy Tales we knew. Towards the end of the week we split into groups and role played Jack and the Beanstalk.



#### Maths

We have been learning about 'greater than' and 'less than'. We played 'Chomp the Crocodile' and 'Guess my number'. One person had to write a number less than 30 and their partner had to guess the number by asking questions using the mathematical terms we had been learning. Later in the week some of us worked on problem solving activities.



#### Science

In science we learnt about germs and how easily they are passed from one person to another. We used glitter to show how quickly germs spread when we come into contact with others or objects.

### History

We are now beginning to explore what we already know about World War 1. We made mind maps to demonstrate our current knowledge. We also had a series of pictures depicting various historical facts that we had to order into a timeline.
