Week Beginning 19th November 2018


Our literacy focus this week has been Kennings poems. They have a decidedly Christmas flavour so, nearer to the time look out for a special poem your child has written in this style!



In phonics we looked at how the letter c can also sound like the letter s. We also looked at the letter i and how it makes a short and long sound. We clapped the number of syllables in our names and in our handwriting books we focused on letters from the ladder family, which including l,i,t,u,j and y.

Days of the week have been the subject for maths this week. We've learned a song about them. See if your child can sing it to you.

In P4C (Philosophy for Children), the Squirrels read the book 'The Rainbow Fish', the Hedgehogs read 'On Sudden Hill'. We then discussed what makes a good friend. The children had some really good ideas and learned some new ways to share them in the classroom.
