

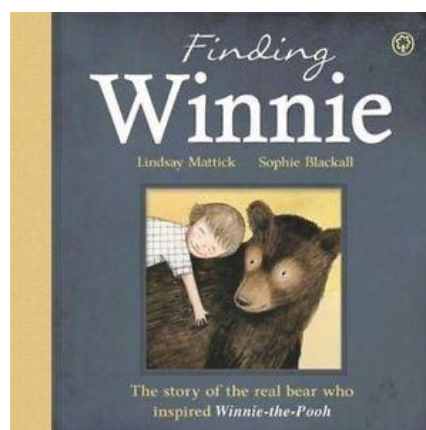
Week Beginning 29th<sup>th</sup> October

This week we began by talking about the events that led up to World War I. Through role play we learned about the countries involved in the war and why it began.

The children were encouraged to bring things to school that helped them to remember experiences in their lives and we looked at some artefacts and equipment that have been used by the military both in the present and in the past.



Our book this week was called Finding Winnie, the children loved the true story about a small Canadian bear which became a regimental mascot and was the inspiration for A.A. Milnes Winnie the Pooh stories.



We based our literacy activities around the book and learned about verbs and nouns.

A big thank you to the parents who were able to come in to school to help paint poppies onto stones. These will be transported to Holyrood church next Monday to create an art installation with other schools.
