Our week began with a whole school trip to Holyrood Church in Stubbington, where we laid our painted poppy stones as a tribute to those who died in World War 1.



In literacy we have been writing letters. We used our imaginations to write home to describe how we might have felt as soldiers fighting in the trenches.

In maths we continued to learn about subtraction using number lines to help us.
