In Maths this week we are continuing to learn about measure and our new focus is on time. We have been learning to tell time to the hour. We learned about the numbers and hands on a clock and what o'clock looks like.

In English we recreated The Gingerbread Man using role play, before creating our story boards and then writing it up using our best handwriting. The children worked really hard and at the end of the week they learned how to review their work, editing what they had written so far.

Handwriting has involved finishing the letters in the ladder family (i,j,l,t,u and y) and we have moved on to the 'one armed robot family' learning the letter r.

Phonics included a recap of the sounds igh,ie and split vowel digraph i_e and , ai, ay and split vowel digraph a_e.

In science we began to think about materials and their properties with a view to building a vessel to help the Gingerbread man cross the river and escape the fox! With so many great plans and ideas would he sink or swim?
