This week in maths we've been learning about money. We looked at coins, began to name them and discussed how much they are worth. It would be great if the children could practise using coins the next time you are at the shops.



In English we have been talking about diaries and their features. We are writing our own diary entries based on what we have done outside school.

In art we completed our Fire of London display by creating silhouettes of buildings to place in the flames.

In phonics we have been learning the different sounds that the digraph 'ou' makes in words like 'cloud', 'soup' and 'mouldy'.

We have been using Sum Dog, Bug Club and See Saw during IT based Cool Time and details of log ins will follow when all children have accessed all three programs.

In P.E. the children are being gymnasts and have started to use equipment such as wall bars to further develop their balancing and travelling skills. We have been practising our throwing and catching to apply to our newly learnt sport; Benchball.
