
Week beginning Monday 18th March 2019

In maths this week we have been revisiting the subject of time. Looking at analogue clocks, we have been learning about what the hour and minute hands look like. We have also looked at where the hands point when it is an o'clock time e.g. 1 or 2 o'clock and the positions they take when it is half past the hour. We pointed out that the hour hand lies between the numbers when it is half past the hour. It would be really helpful if the children could practise this at home.

In English we have read the book 'Katie and the British Artists'. Katie jumped into some pictures at the gallery and we have created a story mountain and a story map, to help us construct our own adventure within a chosen picture. These have been sent home for the children to practise over the weekend, in preparation for writing up on Monday.



In phonics we have been looking at the digraph 'or' and how it is used in words such as 'world' and 'worst'.

Continuing with our art focus we have been looking at more work by Yayoi Kasuma. She is an artist obsessed by dots! We look forward to showing you how we have been inspired by her art on our art gallery day. Each child has submitted a piece of their own art work to be framed and exhibited at the show. Just as in a real exhibition the framed work will be up for sale, to be bought by parents if they wish.
