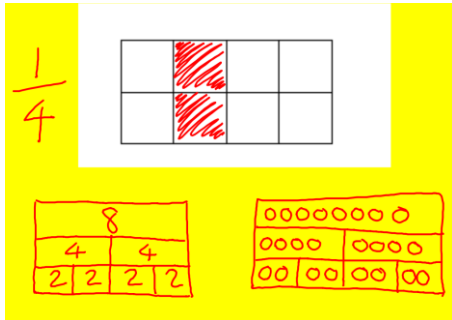
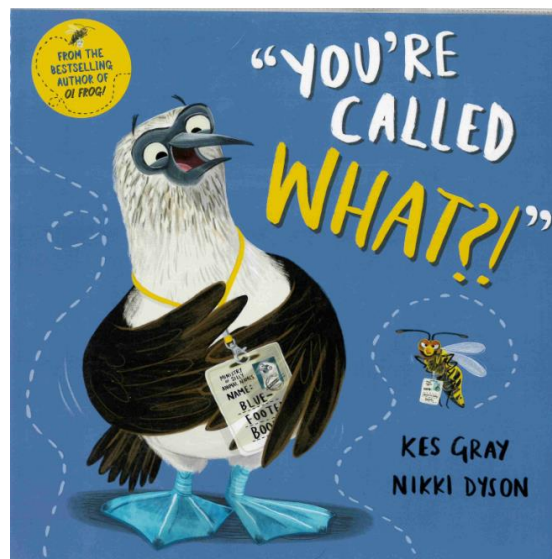


Week beginning 25th February 2019

In maths this week we continued to work on our understanding of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shape and number. The children began to look at fraction walls to record their findings.



In English we looked at the next book for the 'Hampshire Picture Book Awards'. This week it was 'You're called What?!' The children found this story about weird and wonderful creatures really amusing and they went on to produce their own fact file, after researching on the iPads. We also discussed question marks and when to use them in our writing.



In phonics the children have been learning alternative sounds for 's' such as 'st' in castle and whistle and 'se' in mouse and crease.

We were also lucky enough to have a visit from Anne Wan, the author of 'Secrets of the Snow Globe'. She took the children on a magical trip inside her story and set them the challenge of writing their own description of their adventure.
