Some of you may know that one of our Governors, ex-parents and local football coach, Jonathan Pearce, has been diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. Jonathan has decided that his only option is to undergo HSCT (Haematopoietic stem cell transplantation) which is an intense chemotherapy treatment for MS. It aims to stop the damage MS causes by wiping out and then regrowing the immune system, using his own cells. It is important that this is done as soon as possible and therefore Jonathan is currently trying to raise funds to enable him to travel to Moscow where he can have the treatment which costs £40,000.
