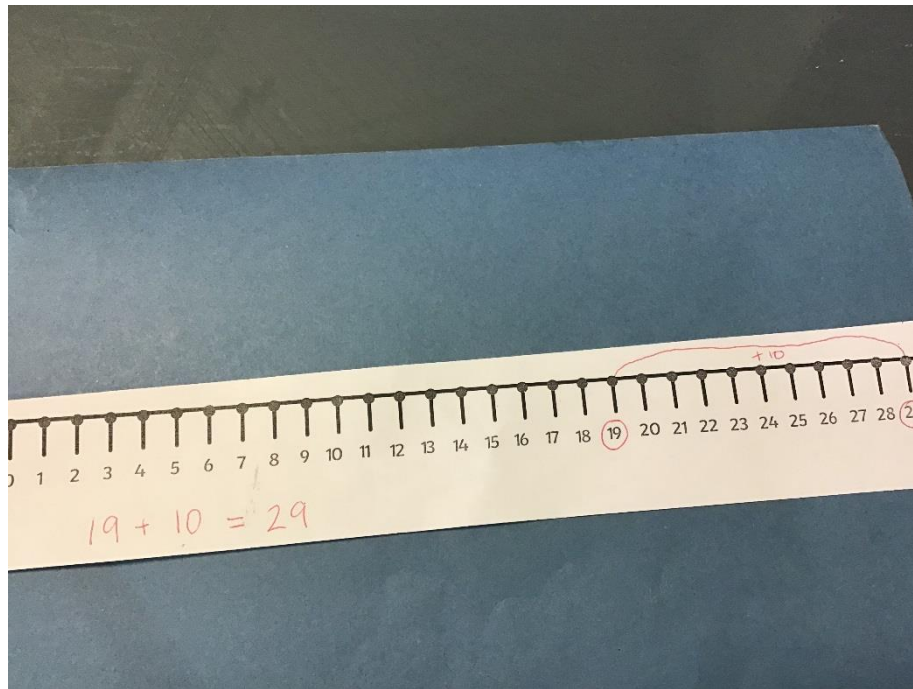


Week beginning 20th May 2019

In maths we used number lines to solve addition number sentences. We demonstrated how we can use the number lines to add 10 by using our knowledge of place value and we noticed that only the tens digit changed and the ones digit always stays the same.

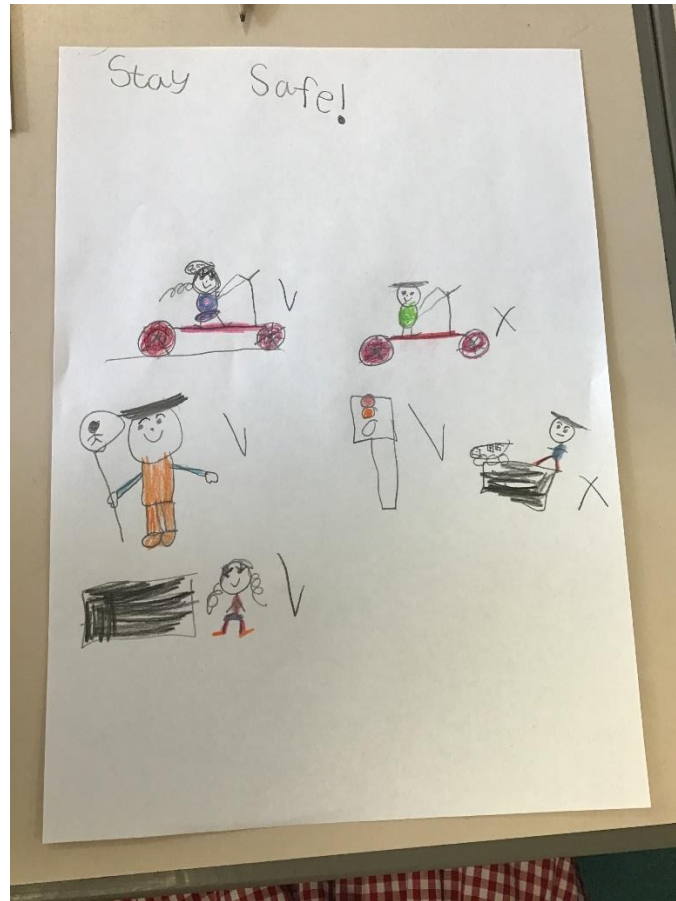


In English we began to write our own adventure story inspired by The Tunnel. The children began by making a story mountain, constructing phrases and ideas for the beginning, middle and end of their story. Then they added the adjectives we had thought about in our lessons to create some fantastic tales.

In Phonics we recapped all our Phase 5 sounds and practised using our sound buttons.

This week in science we explored the properties of materials. We used vocabulary such as hard, soft, opaque and transparent for a variety of objects. We sorted our materials by their properties and made a Venn diagram using sorting hoops.

For PDL we travelled around the school assessing possible hazards and things which have been put in place to keep us safe. We made a poster aimed at Year R children to highlight how they can stay safe on their journey to school and how to stay safe when they are here.
