

Week beginning 29th April 2019

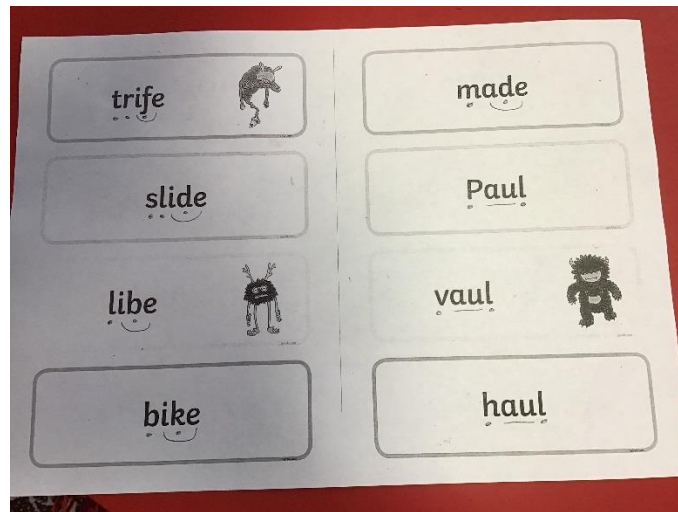
In Maths this week we have been looking at 3D shape. We explored the fact that shapes have faces, edges, sides and vertices and compared and contrasted 2D and 3D shapes.



In English the children began to learn about prefixes. We identified how root words such as 'happy' would change with the addition of a prefix such as 'un' (to make unhappy) and how that would change the meaning of the word. We wrote sentences to include these words, for example, 'I felt unhappy because my bedroom was untidy.'



This week phonics focused on using sound buttons, to identify graphemes within real and alien words.



We introduced the Beebots in Computing. We continued to talk about algorithms and how we will use them to programme the Bots to carry out fun tasks.



In Music we focused on how we can produce long and short sounds using our voices and percussion instruments and in Outdoor Learning we continued gardening by planting our Sunflowers and Runner Beans. As well as tidying up the borders in our Year 1 area.

P.E. this week has provided us with the opportunity to take part in circuit activities using a variety of equipment in the hall. In outdoor P.E. we have begun to take advantage of the warmer weather to

practice our bat and ball skills. We balanced, bounced and tapped balls in the playground, soon we will be able to transfer our talent to hitting balls to a partner and in group games.

For R.E. we shared memories and experiences of our special places. We had such a variety of photos and objects that are special to us. The children were so enthusiastic. It was a wonderful opportunity to come together, chat and listen to each other. It was surprising to find that we all felt the same about the way these places make us feel. We then looked at Christianity and the special places associated with this faith.



Finally we drew a picture and wrote some sentences about our special place.
