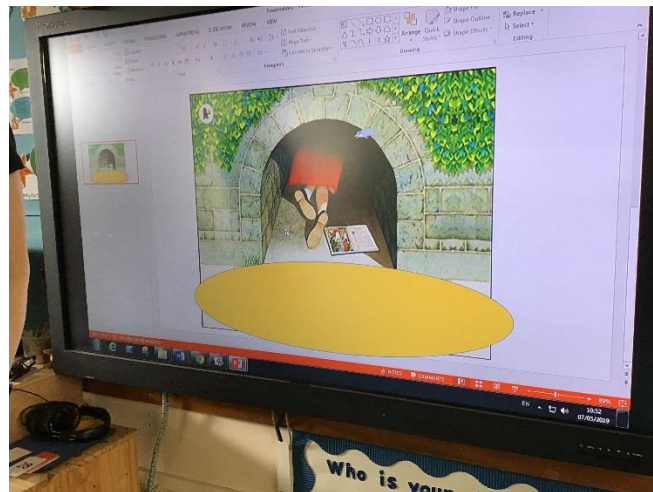


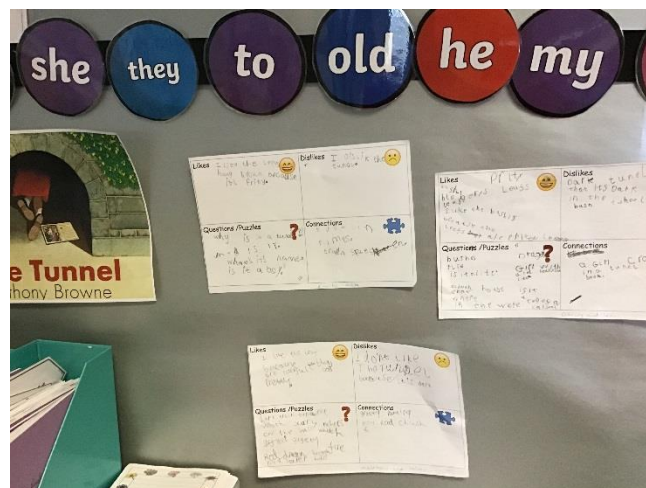
Week beginning 6th May 2019

In Maths this week we have been looking at place value and problem solving.

In English the children began to look at the book 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne.



With a slow reveal (just showing the title page a little at a time, without looking at the book title), we discussed what we thought the book might be about. We used a connections grid to write down what we liked and disliked about the image. We thought about what the picture reminded us of and considered what might be going to happen next in the book.



Next we explored the characters in the book through role play. We discussed how they felt and how Rose and Jack were different and why. We're looking forward to using our ideas and activities so far to help us to write our own narrative.

We then took our imaginations with us to outdoor learning. We went to the forest and had a lot of fun building our own dens and tried to incorporate our own tunnels.

This week phonics focused on the phonics sounds 'ai, ay and a_e' and the words they appear in.

In computing the children made a simple algorithm for a Probot. They had to program it to travel around a grid to find some flowers.

In P.E. Year 1 are continuing to improve their bat and ball skills and rotate around circuits in the hall.
