
Week beginning 10th June 2019

In maths we are talking about multiplication. We used maths language such as multiplication, multiples of, times, lots of and groups of. We solved simple number sentences by representing numbers in groups



Then we looked at arrays, another way of representing multiples. In these operations groups can be clearly seen and prove that in multiplication numbers are commutative i.e. they can be either way around (2x3 or 3x2).
