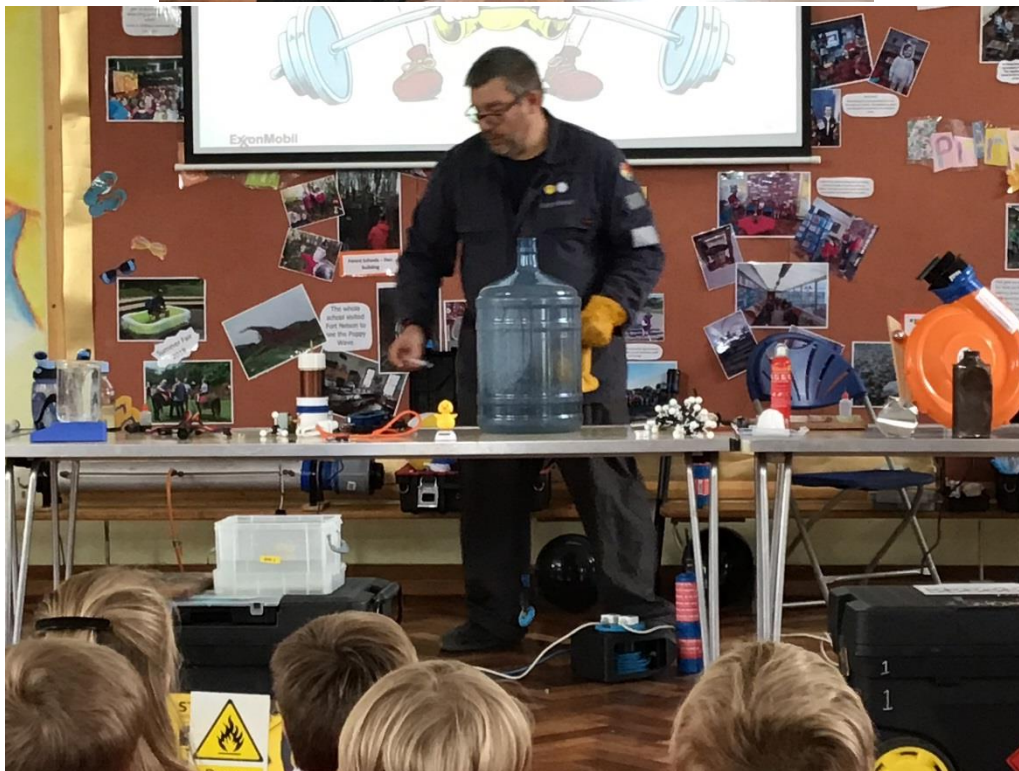


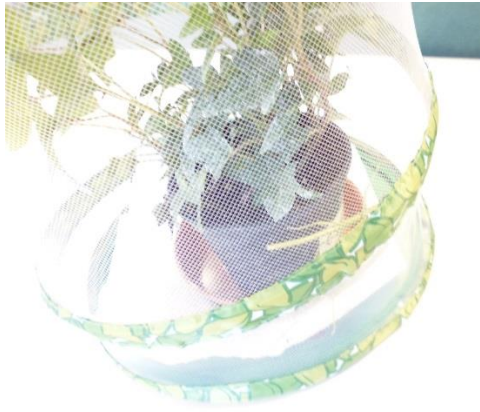
Week beginning 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019

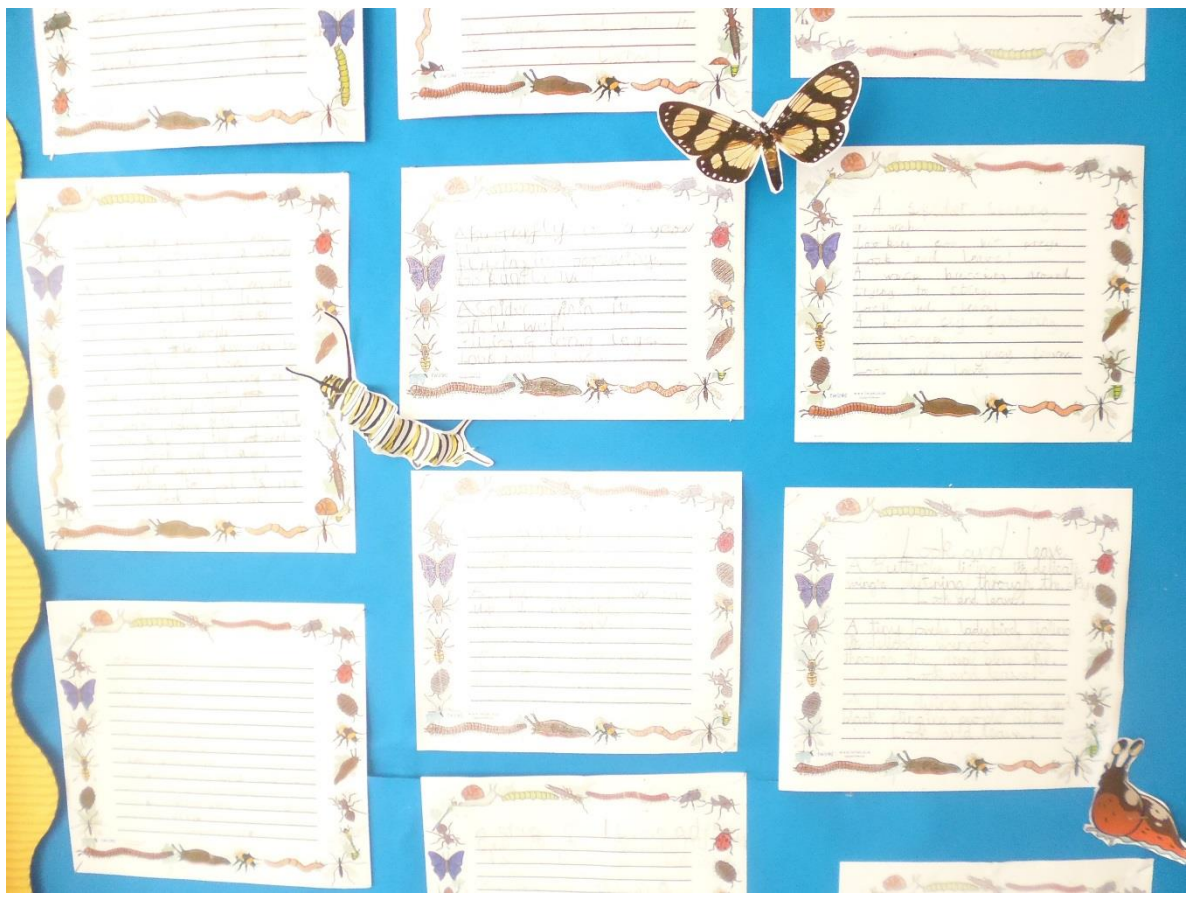




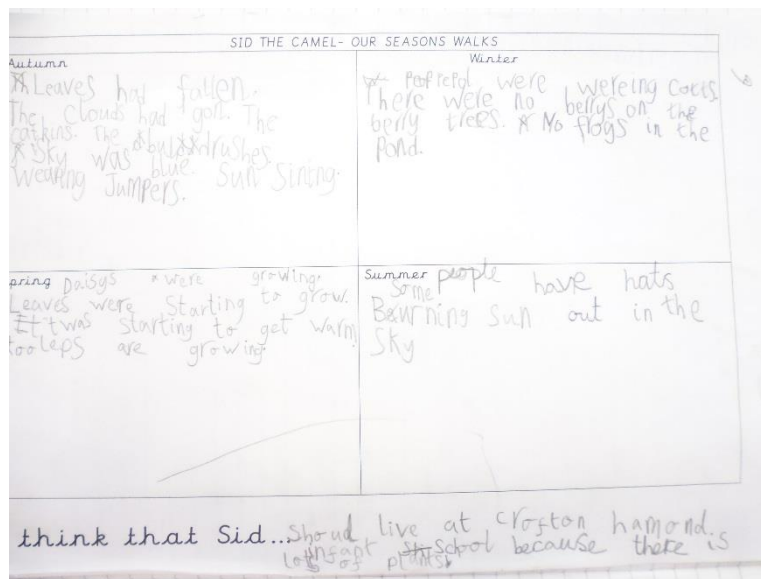
Year 1 hosted two special minibeast guests this week! Miss Whitehead brought in her pet tarantula - Suki and Emily Donaghy brought in her three stick insects! This complimented our work on minibeasts in Science and English.



For English we looked at some poetry and then created our own verses, using our minibeast knowledge. Our 'Look and Leave' minibeast poems have been completed and look great on our new wall display.



We have completed our longitudinal study this week by taking a Summer walk around the school to look at the weather and vegetation. Having looked at this final season and recording how they all differ, we have agreed that Sid the camel should come to England to live.



In maths we have been learning about division through sharing. The children were given problems to solve e.g. I have 15 chickens and 3 fields, how many chickens would be in each? They used the concrete apparatus and drawings to represent their understanding and create a number sentence e.g.  $15 \div 3 = 5$ . We will continue to look at other ways division is used over the coming weeks.
