

Week beginning 20th January

Maths

This week we have been learning about the symbol = and how we use it to solve equations. We also solved missing number problems, moving on to missing number equations. We used different strategies to solve the addition number sentence.

English

Last week we planned an advert to recruit sailors for HMS Victory. This week, we wrote the advert and remembered to use persuasive language, adjectives, conjunctions and commas.

Towards the end of the week we role played the life of a sailor on board HMS Victory, in preparation for next week, when we begin to learn about diary writing.



History

We continue to learn about HMS Victory. This week we learnt about the Battle of Trafalgar through watching a power point and short film. We also learnt about the word 'chronology'. We had to look at pictures of Nelson throughout his lifetime and then order them chronologically. Some of the children moved on to order, chronologically, different naval uniforms, using time lines. Some amazing discussions occurred as a result, with children debating the order of the pictures and providing some very interesting arguments to support their decision.

PE

On Wednesday, we continued to focus on body tension and travelling, but this time we used the apparatus.



On Thursday, the focus continued to be on Netball, we practised a shoulder pass, a chest pass and a bounce pass.
