

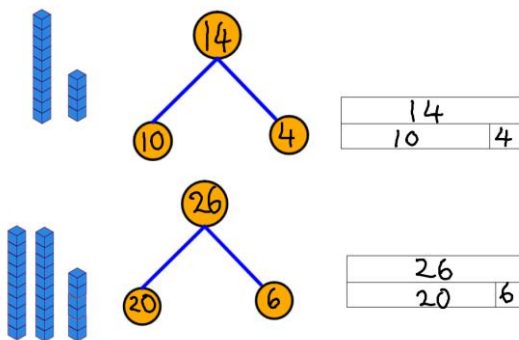
Week beginning 6<sup>th</sup> January 2020

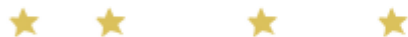
