

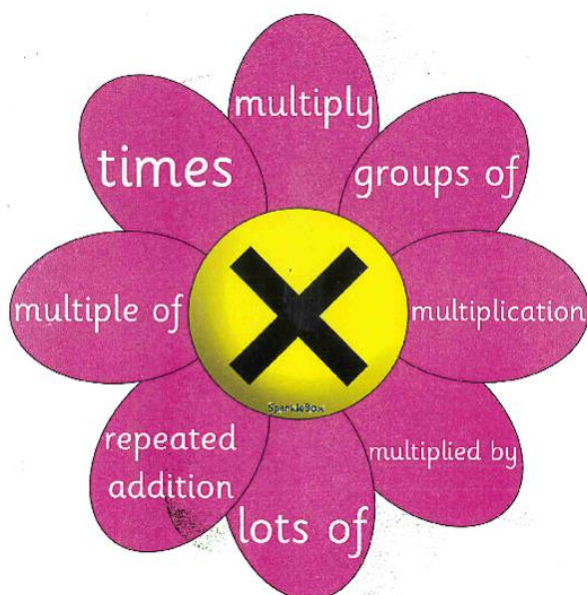
Week beginning 24th February 2020

English

- This week we introduced the children to our second Hampshire book award Story called - The little green hen.
- We stopped half way through the book and used inference to understand what had happened on the page.
- The children then made a prediction of what will happen next. In small groups they took on roles from the book and acted out what they predicted will happen.

Maths

- In maths, we have been working on time. We recapped what we already know about 0'clock and then moved on to half past.
- The children practised making the time, reading the time and drawing the time.
- We also introduced the multiplication symbol to the children. The children then used a variety of equipment to practise making 4×2 . We used number stories to help with this – I have four bags of apples, there are 2 apples in each bag, how many apples do I have all together.

- We re-capped the diagraphs that make the **oo** sound –

Oo oo poo at the zoo.

Ew ew chew the stew.

Ue ue the glue is blue.
