

## Year 1 Blog – week beginning 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2020

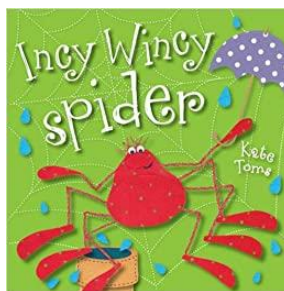
It has been a very busy first week back in year 1! Here is a little snippet of what we have been learning so far:

### Phonics

In phonics we are practicing blending two consonants together. For example /nk/, /mp/ and /nd/. We have not had any new spellings this week.

### English

This term we are focusing on rhyme. We learnt the nursery rhyme 'Incy Wincy Spider' and created our own actions. Some of us performed to the class!



### Maths

We are learning to recognise British coins. We have been sorting and ordering coins.

### Computing

In computing we have been thinking about e-safety and how we can keep ourselves safe online. We know that if there is something we are not sure about, we should always ask or tell an adult!



### PDL (Personal Development Learning)

In PDL we exploring the question 'what makes us unique?'. We listened to the story 'It's okay to be different' by Todd Parr, and discussed what we like, what we have in common and what makes us special.

### PE

PE days are Tuesday and Thursday. On Tuesday we began our dance topic, where we began to create a 'firework' themed dance. On Thursday, we began our 'ball skills' unit with Mrs Reeves.
