### Phonics

In phonics, we are continuing to practice blending two consonants together- /sp/, /st/, and /tr/.

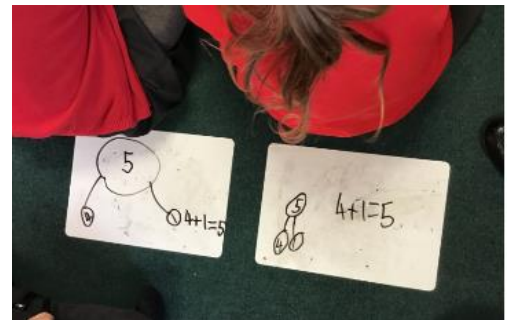
We also looked at adding the suffix 'ing' to a root word to make a new word. Eg, cooking, playing etc. This week's words to read and spell are: says, push, pull, here

### English

We began by looking at the book 'Each Peach Pear Plum'. We talked about what we liked about the book, what we didn't like, what puzzled us about the book and what it reminded us of. As the book is based on the games 'I spy' we then had to find some Nursery Rhyme characters that had been hidden around the classroom. We then used prepositional language to create our own version of 'Each Peach Pear Plum' eg. I spy Goldilocks hiding behind the clock.

### Maths

We have carried on learning about addition this week and have also been exploring the = sign. We found out that as well as 'equals' it also means 'the same as' and that things either side of the = sign have to balance. We then looked at part-part whole models and how this relates to addition number sentences.
