

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on from my email this morning I am now in a position to be able to give you more information about the upcoming day of strike action on Thursday 2nd March.

Year 2 will only be open to the children of critical workers and those the school has identified as being potentially vulnerable. They will not be taught the usual Year 2 timetable, but will be supervised by a teacher and members of support staff to complete other activities.

Year 1 will be open to *all* children as normal. They will be taught their usual lessons.

Year R will only be open to the children of critical workers and those the school has identified as being potentially vulnerable. They will not be taught the usual Year R timetable, but will be supervised by a teacher and members of support staff to complete other activities.

Other children are to remain at home and a follow up email with suggestions for home learning will be sent to you next week.

Vulnerable children - An email will be sent to you today to inform you as to whether your child has been identified by the school as being potentially vulnerable and therefore being offered a school place for the day.

Children of critical workers - If you believe that your child is the child of critical workers, and you will require a place in school, [please complete this form](#) by midday on Tuesday 28th February.

Free School Meals - We would like to make sure that children who are in receipt of benefit based free school meals have access to a school lunch on the day of the strike. This would need to be collected from the school office between 11:30am and 12:00pm. If you would like your child to receive a school packed lunch [please complete this form](#) by midday on Monday 27th February.

Other information - Breakfast and after school club will run as usual. If you have booked in on Thursday 2nd March and you are not going to be taking up your place, please could you inform the office before the 48hours or you will still be charged. As previously stated, World Book Day will be moved to Wednesday 1st March.
