

Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my previous messages to you about industrial action, the NEU are holding a regional strike day on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March. Due to the number of teachers who have told me that they are planning on taking industrial action, it is highly likely that we will not be able to keep the school open safely on this date. Therefore, there will be at least a partial closure of the school. Now that I have heard back from all teachers as to their intentions, I am putting a plan into place today as to who the school will remain open to and hope to be able to share this information with you by the end of the day.

In the meantime, I wanted to give you as much time as possible to start to plan alternative childcare arrangements in case your child is affected by the closure.

Please also note that World Book Day will be moved to Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March to ensure all children are able to take part.
