Wednesday 12th June 9.15-10.00 a.m.	SURNAMES A-L	Visit into school for 'Stay and Play' session. A chance for you and your child to come into school and meet the teachers and friends. We will have lots of play based activities in the hall and will finish the session with a snack. It will be an opportunity to ask questions and find out more information.
Wednesday 12th June 10.30-11.15 a.m.	SURNAMES M-Z	
Wednesday 19th June 9.15-10.00 a.m.	SURNAMES A-L	Another opportunity to come into school for a 'Stay and Play' in the hall with your child to see the teachers again and have a play! This session will include songs and rhymes group time.
Wednesday 19th June 10.30-11.15 a.m.	SURNAMES M-Z	
Wednesday 26th June 9.15-10.00 a.m.	SURNAMES A-L	First visit into your child's new classroom. Your child will find out who their new teacher is and which class they will be in. You and your child will get to go into their new classroom to explore the environment and meet all the adults. You will receive a pack with more information about school uniforms, lunches and so on.
Wednesday 26th June 10.30-11.15 a.m.	SURNAMES M-Z	
Wednesday 3rd July 9.15-10.15 a.m.	All	Children to spend time in their new class with their teacher. Parents to meet our Headteacher, Chair of Governors and members of our PTA (CHIPs).
Wednesday 10th July 9.15-10.15 a.m.	All	Children to spend time in their new class with their teacher. Tea and coffee available for parents in the hall and chance to meet other parents etc. Our Parent support advisor Lisa Noice and SENCO will be available to chat.
Monday 2nd and Tuesday 3rd September	All	Whole school inset days – school closed to all children.
4th-6th September	All	Home visit week. You will be given a 20 minute timeslot for your child's class teacher to visit you at home on one of these days. You will be given a letter detailing your personal home visit time on the 26 th of June.
Monday 9th September	All	This will be your child's first morning in school. The children will begin on a part time timetable; details of which are on the accompanying letter.

Due to space restrictions we are unfortunately unable to accommodate any siblings other than non-mobile babies during the sessions.
